Teaching the Faith

Totus Tuus, a Latin motto of St. Pope John Paul II which means “*Totally Yours*”, is a summer program dedicated to catechizing youth throughout the Diocese of Green Bay.

Totus Tuus missionary teams of four young adults, two men and two women, travel to parishes to share their love for Christ and His Church through week-long parish missions. They inspire students through stories of saints, skits, music and age-appropriate lessons which help the students to grow as missionary disciples.

Missionaries teach, pray and eat as a community, building upon a spirit of self-giving and mutual respect. Basic needs, including meals and housing, are provided by host families at each parish. The Holy Spirit is active and working within the missionary teams to make their summer a success!

Qualities of a Totus Tuus Missionary:

- Confirmed, practicing, young-adult Catholic who is faithful to the teachings of the Magisterium.
- At least 18 years of age prior to May 29, 2022.
- Willing to teach, interact with and mentor children and teenagers.
- Giving oneself more fully to Christ and eager to grow in a life of prayer and discernment.
- Committed to living in community.
- Prepared for a packed daily schedule in a different parish each week.
- Ready to have fun with their team and a lot of students!



Five Marks of Totus Tuus

1. Proclamation of the Gospel - to arouse faith.
2. Explanation - examination of the reasons for our beliefs.
3. Christian Witness- an experience of Christian living.
4. Celebration of the Sacraments - especially Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation.
5. Active witness of Missionary Discipleship.

Changing Lives

DETAILS

- Paid training begins May 29 and ends June 9, 2022.
- Training includes theological formation with area clergy, as well as teaching methods.
- Teaching begins June 12 and ends August 5, 2022.
- Closing Retreat August 5-6, 2022.
- One week of vacation from July 2 to the morning of July 8. (Unpaid)
- 24 hours off each week.
- Additional vacation may be granted for a weekend obligation like a wedding or family reunion.
